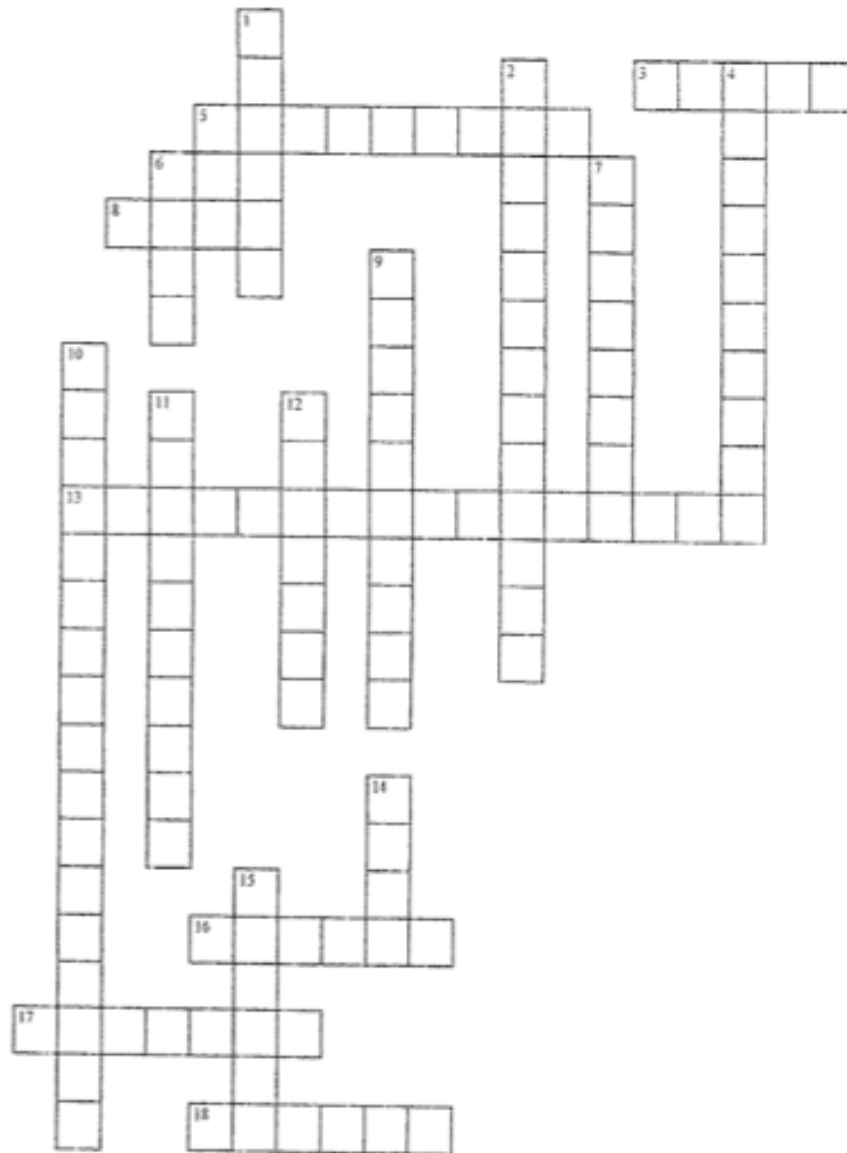


# Carolina Crossword
